SUBJECT : Mary Jane LAND

1. According to a source of ABCASSOWARY/29, Subject who is a student of music at the Rochester School of Music, travelled to the Soviet Union in the summer of 1962 with the Eastman Philharmonic Orchestra of Rochester, New York. Subject is about 21 years of age. In August of 1962, she told the source that she was staying at 890 West End Avenue, New York 25, New York, Apt. 2A. She gave her telephone number as RI 9-7243. Subject said that she would be returning to Rochester in September.

2. Subject reportedly had contact in Lvov (a chance meeting) with a female teacher of English at the Lvov Conservatory. Details of this contact are not known except that the English teacher in Lvov asked Subject to convey her greetings to the source and to warn him to be very careful about what he writes in his letters to her. The English teacher and source are old friends and are in correspondence with each other.

3. This information is being passed on to you in the event you should be interested in contacting Subject. However, because this information comes from a source of A/29 and it is not known whether or not anyone else is knowledgeable of Subject's contact with the English teacher, you are requested to take every precaution not to disclose that you are aware of the contact made by Subject.
