1. At the meeting on 20 Nov 1963 OLEKSIY told Subject that his last name was BOLBOTENKO. Their next meeting was fixed for 29 Nov 1963 at 15.00 hrs on the corner of 70th Street and West End Avenue.

2. OLEKSIY was very much interested in Prof Yuri SHEVELOV of Columbia. He "regretted" that such ^abig talent was wasted abroad. As a proof of high esteem SHEVELOV was still enjoying among his Soviet colleagues BOLBOTENKO mentioned the fact that when BULAKHOVSKIY (Academician) was dying he told those present there that Prof SHEVELOV was the only ^{one capable} to head the Academy of Sciences of Ukrainian SSR.

3. OLEKSIY brought Subject 4 or 5 pictures of his family. Among those is also a picture of Subject with his wife. Two or three pictures of his son from 1942 and 1951 seemed to be quite recent. Together with the fact that the (sizes) measures for Subject's son given to Subject by Oleksiy are different from those on the picture, Subject is doubtful now as to whether Oleksiy has ever seen his son, at all.

4. Subject seems to have now regained his composure and become more critical of OLEKSIY'S approach to him. He wants to get his son's address and then if possible to break all connections with Oleksiy.
