SUBJECT: Information of Possible Dissemination Value

1. The following information received from an AERODYNAMIC source was obtained by an American citizen, who travelled to the USSR and Poland in late summer 1963, from a personal friend, a Pole who until October 1963 was Director of a home for mentally retarded children in Janowice. The Pole told the source that there were Soviet missile bases between Zielona Gora and Ilowa, and near Lodz.

2. Another Polish acquaintance of the source informed her that there were Soviet rocket bases between Zielona Gora and Ilowa, and a Soviet military camp in Swidnica. He also said there were Soviet rocket bases between Lodz and Lask-Pabianice. While driving by car from Zielona Gora to Ilowa, source was stopped three times by police and requested to show her documents.
