SUBJECT : Polish Citizens of Possible Operational Interest

1. It is believed the following will be of interest to you. The information was obtained from an AERODYNAMIC source who personally is acquainted with the individuals named.

2. When the source visited in Poland in the late summer of 1963, she was told by the following individual that he would be willing to work for the West. All the details of their conversation are not known to this office.

ZAWADZKI was Director of a home for mentally retarded children in Janowice until October of 1963. He is 50 years of age, married and the father of 3 daughters and 1 son. He is missing his right eye which he lost during WWII. ZAWADZKI is a Party member. He served as an officer in the Polish Army during WWII. A snapshot of him is on file in SR/CA/E.

3. Dr. Seweryn CHAJTMAN, Director of the Institute of Organization and Economics, Industrial Engineering Department, Warsaw Politechnical University, presently is in the United States on official business and plans to stay until April. CHAJTMAN is interested in American statistical machines. While in New York, he is living at the Pickwick Arms Hotel on East 52nd Street. It is believed he is a Polish Jew. He is a member of the Party, married, but has no children. His wife, who has a PhD in economics, teaches at the Warsaw Politechnical University. CHAJTMAN told the source he is trying to bring his wife to the United States and that if he is successful, they will ask for asylum here. His home address is: Warsaw, 6 Rakowicka Street.
