Friends in Lvov told source that in late summer of 1963 the whole population of a kolkhoz near Zbaras went on strike in protest against the arrest of a peasant who had written to his relatives in the US about life in the Soviet Union being like life in hell. The kolkhoz population remained on strike for several days in spite of the threats of rayon and higher authorities until the arrested peasant was released.
