REDWOOD AERODYNAMIC - AECASSOWARY Collaborators in Italy

1. The Subject of reference B is an AECASSOWARY collaborator whose services it is planned to utilize in contact operations against Soviet citizens who travel in Italy. When AECASSOWARY/29 (Idan A) was in Rome recently, the Subject told him he had a brief contact with [] in Milan in late April. [] was in the company of other individuals so Subject and [] did not become involved in any long discussion. They did, however, exchange addresses, and [] invited Subject to come back to visit him. He promised to call on the Subject in Rome when he visits in that city. The Subject had not been instructed to effect the contact with AZARIA. He undertook it on his own initiative during a visit in Milan when he learned of [] presence there. To date, nothing further has been heard regarding this contact but the Subject promised to keep A/29 informed of any new developments. The exchange of visits between the Subject and [] may never materialize, depending on how interested the KGB is in Subject. In view of [] contact with [] and the latter's identity as a KGB agent, we request your view's on pursuing or cancelling this contact which A/29 can have done. However, in view of the fact that Subject is unwitting of any intelligence involvement, we see no harm in letting the contact proceed normally to see whether or not [] attempts to recontact the Subject and there base the decision as to how or whether to proceed on what develops during the contact.

2. A/29 plans also to develop the Subject of reference C as a collaborator in contact operations.

3. Although the Subjects of both references B and C were known to the AECASSOWARIES in the past, their services have never before been utilized operationally. Under the new plan to intensify Project AERODYNAMIC contact operational effort, A/29,

as the principal operations officer for A/1 (Iden B), is permitted to travel to various areas in the Free World (as an official ~~ASSASSINATIVE~~, Iden C representative) to reassess existing A/1 assets and develop new ones in order to organize and train a net of A/1 operatives in areas which offer the greatest operational potential or to areas in which A/1 already has collaborators who are considered suitable for contact operations. A/29 is obligated to report at least sufficient biographical information on his principal collaborators in each area so that full operational approvals can be obtained on them. He is not obligated to report on individuals whose services are utilized by his collaborators in their respective areas because such information could not be obtained without revealing to some degree the collaborator's involvement with A/29. A/29 collaborators never make any attempt at elicitation or recruitments. Their role is merely to establish and develop contacts on the basis of mutual interests (i.e., nationality background, professional interests, etc.) and report to A/29 any biographical information obtained on the Soviet citizen, fields of interest, attitudes, etc. A/29 will be available for on-the-scene supervision of any operation against a Soviet target of particular interest which may develop in any of the areas. This eliminates the need for KUBARK staff involvement, except where deemed operationally desirable. In the event ~~ASSASSINATIVE~~/29's activities against a Soviet target in any given area infringe upon the responsibilities and activities of another KUBARK division, the target will be turned over to the area division.
