

SUBJECT : Information of Possible Interest
for Dissemination

1. An Armenian from Erevan told an AERODYNAMIC source that a Byelorussian named fnu SAVCHENKO tried to kill Nikita Khrushchev when the latter visited Minsk in 1961.

2. The source of the information may be described as a U. S. citizen, a probably reliable but untested source who travelled in the Soviet Union for a period of several weeks in late 1963.
