Non-Diplomatic Soviets Working in Yugoslavia**

ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES

Action Required: See Paragraph 2.

1. While vacationing in Yugoslavia in July 1964, a Western businessman met a Soviet Ukrainian, (fn) PANCHUK, in a restaurant in Zagreb. PANCHUK, (variant spelling: PANCZUK), about 40 years of age, said that he had been born in Drozdych, USSR, and that his home was in Odessa. PANCHUK also said that he was assigned to work in Yugoslavia as a "fitter," along with three other Soviets--a Ukrainian from Kiev and two Russians from Tula. Although Source held a fairly lengthy talk with PANCHUK, no further information was acquired concerning the number of such Soviet citizens employed in Yugoslavia or exactly where they might be working. It appears, however, that PANCHUK is working in a technical capacity in Yugoslav industry.

2. Headquarters would appreciate any information which you may be able to acquire concerning such non-diplomatic Soviets assigned to Yugoslavia. A mechanism exists through which access to such persons might be possible.
