a. Action Reported:**a) By Field:**

1. Publication of the newspapers in the Ukrainian language ("Suchasna Ukraina" and "Ukrainsky Samostiynik") is continuing and gaining wider circulation and recognition among the Ukrainian emigre circles throughout the world. In addition, specific political action has been undertaken to publicize the Ukrainian underground contact with concentration camp inmates in the USSR. Meetings were arranged in Bonn, Munich, and Vienna. The resulting publicity in the German, Austrian and Swiss newspapers emphasized the internal colonialism of the Soviet regime towards its own minorities and the slave labor camp tactics continued despite the advertised liberalization.

b) By Headquarters:

1. Prolog Associates in N.Y. continued to produce radio scripts for daily 15-min. broadcasts through PYREX. In addition, an appeal to UNO was launched for the purpose of advertising underground contacts with Ukrainian inmates in the concentration camps. This appeal was launched simultaneously with similar action in the Field, and it has gained wide publicity in newspapers which were utilized for a series of meetings in the Ukrainian emigre circles.

2. Action was taken to take over gradually the Ukrainian broadcasts from Radio Nacional (Madrid). The leader of the Ukrainian group producing the scripts for Radio Nacional (Mr. Tsimbalist) established liaison with Prolog Associates and offered to follow the leadership of Prolog Associates. Tsimbalist personally is expected to emigrate and settle in the U.S.A. When this takes place, his position will be taken over by a representative of Prolog Associates, presently residing in Paris. Clearances on both Tsimbalist and Mr. Markus (the proposed candidate) will be implemented.

3. Action was taken to counter the repatriation to the USSR from Argentina. The representatives of the group in Buenos Aires were requested to provide detailed information regarding the condition of the emigres and the reason for large-scale repatriation.

4. An English language publication designed for distribution in Afro-Asian countries has been completed and forwarded to the Field for printing and utilization as propaganda against Soviet infiltration in the newly independent countries of the East.
