1. At a dinner party at Rev L's house in Edmonton, Alberta Ina asked him what Metropolitan SLIPYI was doing. Rev L replied that Metropolitan did not make any anti-Soviet declarations. Ina commented that she meant something else, namely, whether he was active in general. On this occasion she told him confidentially that in Lviv there are active various Ukrainian underground groups mainly among the youth. Most of them have a clearly nationalistic "profile". Her son, among others, was expelled from the Institute for having been involved in one of those underground groups. Ina had great difficulties to beg out for him his re-immatriculation. She added that during Stalin period her son surely would have been shot.
