1. Slavko covered both ballets in Paris from 24 Nov to 15 Dec 1964. The Kiev Ballet arrived 27 Nov 1964 and left Paris 14 Dec 1964. Slavko was helped by M and Sh of Paris, and partly by I.K. of Munich who came on 27 Nov 1964 to Paris and stayed there until 7 Dec 1964. Slavko was particularly successful in establishing rapport with the whole group, made friends with artists and administrators, took care of translating French press-cuttings for the ballets on their performance, and practically talked to every member of both groups. 30 books and Suchasnist-magazines were handed over to artists and administrators.

2. On 11 Dec 1964 a dinner party was organized at Dr J. MUSIANOWYCZ' house at 44 rue Jeanne d'Arc, Paris 13. From the Soviet side were present:

From emigres were : Dr J. MUSIANOWYCZ and wife, Dr VIRSTA, ZHUKOVSKYI, Prof. SZUMOWSKI, Olga REPETYLO, MYTROVICH, and a Georgian emigre employed with Youly Algaroff Agency of 252 Fbg St. Honore, Paris. Algaroff was Ballets' impresario in Paris.

3. On 8 Jan 1965, after Kiev-Ballet's return from Italy, a dinner party was organized at A. ZUKOVSKY'S house, 55 rue des Pyrenees, Paris 20, at which were present:

YOSYFYSHYN, and MYEROVICH.

Boris GUSTIAKOV who was together with LAVIN at VILDEA'S house prior to the party at MIKOVSKYS refused to go to MIKOVSKY and returned to hotel. Also, Valentina KALINOVSKAYA with whom MYTNOVICH spent a few hours at the hotel and in the city helping her to buy medicine and gifts during the day, remained in hotel, though was invited, too.
