The following information about the Subject was received in a report of a contact with Danylo Danylovych FEDORIACHENKO AKA FEDORYACHENKO, Vice Director of the Kiev Ballet, in Paris in November 1964. FEDORYACHENKO told the source of our information that he met with the Subject in 1962 in the Crimea, and that the Subject has remained his main source of information about the Ukrainian emigration.

2. During a conversation another source of this office had with the Subject on 21 December 1964, at the Windsor Hotel in Montreal, Canada, following a press conference for the local French and English language press with a Soviet Ukrainian tourist group headed by Kateryna Antonovna KOLOSOVA, the Subject told our source that during his trip to the Soviet Union last year he criticized Soviet Ukrainian cultural and Party leaders because they tolerate Russification in the Ukraine. The Subject said that as a result, he was surveilled constantly "by two KGBists." He protested to the authorities but the surveillance continued.
