We passed the substance of the information contained in referenced dispatch to SMABOVE on 17 August and received the following response from them on 17 September:

A. Thank you for the information concerning the gift sent to Ambrose HOLOWACH by Katerina KOLOSOVA, Chairman of the Society for Cultural Contacts with Ukrainians Abroad.

B. This is not the first indication that we have had of K.G.B. interest in Ambrose HOLOWACH who is the Provincial Secretary for Alberta. That HOLOWACH should have come to the attention of the R.I.S. is not surprising when one considers his background. He was born about 1915 in Canada of Ukrainian parents. He studied music in Vienna from 1931 to 1935 and is believed to have become involved at that time in Ukrainian emigre politics. In 1953 he was elected to the federal parliament, and in 1957 he was a member of the Canadian delegation to the United Nations. He lost his parliamentary seat in the 1958 elections, and since then he has been prominent in Alberta provincial politics. He was appointed Provincial Secretary in 1962. The office is of provincial cabinet level, and much of HOLOWACH's work is involved with cultural affairs.

C. We are very interested in any attempted development of HOLOWACH by the R.I.S. and would appreciate being provided with any further information which might come to your attention.
