

# DISPATCH

Meeting with AECASSOWARYS/2 and 29 on 5 October 1965

1. Circumstances of Meeting. In view of the uncertainties apparently involved in the newly established contact for AECASSOWARY/29 with [ ] of the New York Base, I felt it appropriate to discuss the matter with the AECASSOWARYs. We did so in my hotel room on 5 October.

2. My primary concern was to explain to them that I thought the liaison was probably a good step and that I had been very much in favor of it. Essentially, I said the following concerning how I thought it ought to work and what it would involve: the liaison would concern the Soviets permanently or for prolonged periods based in New York with whom the AECASSOWARYs had contact. The purpose was to provide a means whereby all of our operations concerned with these Soviets could be coordinated on the spot. The most important advantage, it seems to me, that we could gain from it is a more direct connection to ODENVY to assure us that their involvement with the AECASSOWARYs would be kept to a minimum. I said that I was concerned that there be no division of the authority on the part of our organization in regard to the running of the AERODYNAMIC Project and that that authority remained as it had been before in the hands of [ ] [ ] The amount of information that would be passed to [ ] would be limited, it seemed to me, because the involvements of the AECASSOWARYs with the Soviets stationed in New York were not many.

3. AECASSOWARY/2 seemed to be a little more skeptical of how it might all work out than AECASSOWARY/29. 29 said that he felt he had understood what [ ] was driving at toward the end of their conversation, but had been confused at the beginning of it. He said that at present he feels he does understand what it is all about and does not feel disturbed about it. He asked whether this contact might also be able to provide them with listening devices, cameras or other technical equipment if the occasion warranted it. I told them I didn't know whether that was possible or not but it was certainly proper for him to raise the question when talking to [ ] (I referred [ ] by his first name.) A/29 asked what he should do about the contact now. I told him that I would get in touch with [ ] and that [ ] would probably call him. At any rate, I told him, we would let him know what to do about resuming the contact.

4. No other substantive subjects were discussed at our meeting.
