MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD:

SUBJECT: M. LEVYSHCHENKO

1. A sensitive and reliable CI source has indicated that Orest HORODYSKY, 3308 West Palmer Street, Chicago, had met M. LEVYSHCHENKO, an editor of VISTI Z UKRAINY, Kiev, when the latter visited Chicago on a tour of the US and Canada, and that he took exception to LEVYSHCHENKO's reports, published later, about conditions seen on the trip. Scoring the reports as biased and untrue, HORODYSKY had lambasted the Communists about conditions in Ukraine, and LEVYSHCHENKO had reportedly wondered how he could say such things before seeing actual conditions, but had been gratified over the report that HORODYSKY would like to send his son to the Ukraine.
