REDWOOD AERODYNAMIC -- Ivan V. KOLASKA

1. Regarding your inquiry in Paragraph 2 of Reference A, as stated in Reference B, the source of the information "speculated" that KOLASKA identified to KOROTYCH the names of Soviets in contact with OUN/M people in the West, and it is probable this would have been done while KOLASKA was still in the Soviet Union. It is not known whether KOLASKA and KOROTYCH knew each other in the Soviet Union. However, KOLASKA was in Kiev during his stay in the Soviet Union so it is possible they did meet. There is no way to substantiate this supposition unless KOLASKA personally was asked about it.

2. We were extremely interested in the information regarding arrests of Ukrainian nationalists contained in  3075 of 17 February 1966, particularly since it added credence to the information of Reference B. This will be discussed further in a separate dispatch.
