1. In view of the interest Subject expressed in Ukrainian-language newspapers, we are forwarding UNDER SEPARATE COVER some Ukrainian-language literature which might be passed to him via [] The literature was all published under Project AERODYNAMIC for distribution to Soviet citizens, but it is all overt and also sold in the West through book stores which are frequented by Ukrainian emigres and on a subscription basis by the publisher. We leave [] to your discretion the best cover to use to explain [] source for the literature. Perhaps he can say he had put himself on the mailing list of the printer. We request that the collaboration between the publisher and WOFAC be protected and that the literature not be passed if there is danger of such exposure. The literature is nationalist in content but not hostile or malicious. It endeavors objectively to analyze Soviet realities by acknowledging any significant progress made under the Soviet system and supporting all criticism by convincing evidence. The journal contains material of literary, artistic, historical and political nature of interest to both Soviet and emigre Ukrainians and authored by individuals of various political tendencies. It frequently contains literature translated into Ukrainian from other Western languages.

2. It may very well be that Subject is not interested from the literary standpoint at all. However, if [] finds the Subject is willing to accept the literature being forwarded, it is felt he will find it of interest whatever his motive for requesting it happens to be. In the literature, the Subject will find information not only about emigre personalities and activities but also information about Soviet personalities and events, past and present, not otherwise available to him.

3. To our knowledge, there is no Ukrainian-language newspaper published in Rio. There is a weekly newspaper, KHLIBOROB, published in Curitiba by ESTAVAO V. KOBYLANSKY, rua Emiliano Perneta 665, Apt. 1301. KHLIBOROB can

be described as a political organ of the local OUN/Melnick (Organization of Ukrainian Nationalists/Melnick faction) organization and strongly rightist in view. It is not known what outlet there is for the publication, except for the editor and publisher, KOBYLANSKY, who seems to use his home address as the address for the newspaper. Other Curitiba Ukrainian-language publications are those published by the local Basilian Fathers and theological students, PRATSYA, TSVIRKUN and BDZHILKA.

4. We assume that any use by [] of this material with or through [] will be in the context of the latter's operational security vis a vis Subject. Headquarters will be interested in any comments made by the Subject about the literature, if it is passed to him. Additional similar material can be forwarded upon request.
