On Friday, Uncle told me a source of his reported that a ~~group~~ ^{delegation} of Ukrainian Progressives from Canada were going (or had already gone) to Moscow where they intended to remain until they got a clear-cut explanation of the present policy on the nationalities question.

According to Uncle, today, the 1 April issue of Radyanska Ukraina has an article to the effect that such a delegation arrived - that it had been invited to Moscow for official discussions with Party representatives. The article lists the names of the members of the delegation. He is sending it to me in today's mail. I will send to Ottawa when received.

A letter was received today from Problems of Communism thanking them for sending the report regarding the arrests. The letter states, according to Uncle, that a special issue of the journal is presently in preparation and that it is planned to include one, perhaps two, articles on nationalism, and that "you can be sure that the problem of Ukrainian intellectuals" will be given consideration.

KOROTYCH told a source in Chicago that when he returns home this summer, he will be going out to Zeleniy Klyn (near Khabarovsk) where he will be concerned with Ukrainian-language broadcasts to Ukrainians living in the area. He said the decision to start such broadcasts was made to counteract Ukr-language broadcasts to the area by the Chinese.
