

MEMORANDUM FOR: SB/RR

SUBJECT : ^{Reports of} Disagreement in high Soviet Government circles

SOURCE : AECASSCWERY/29 (usually reliable source) from a Western citizen who visited the Soviet Union in July of this year (untested but probably reliable source)

Soviet Ukrainian Literary critic Ivan Svitlychnyy, who was sent to a corrective labor camp in late 1965 after being accused of copying and disseminating nationalist literature published in the West, and who was later released, told a Western citizen who visited Kiev in late July of this year that ^{he had been informed by an intelligence source} there is severe quarreling going on in the highest echelons of Soviet Government and that some changes are expected "at the very top" in the near future.
