The following information has been received from # 19:

1. According to Rev. Vynnychuk, fnu of Argentina with whom Source had talked immediately after his arrival from the Soviet Union to Rome, early Nov 1967, people in Kiev and Lvov were expecting a new wave of arrests and persecutions ~~following~~ following the end of October Revolution celebrations. There were also rumors that Ivan DZIUBA was one of those to be soon arrested.

2. According to Roman Ukrainian catholic circles, Rev. VELYCHKIVSKY of Lvov, Redemptorist, has probably been already designated as SLIPY'S successor, by the latter.

3. Rev. HRYNYK Bazyli (Vasyl) of Poland, Ukrainian catholic priest, is to be soon nominated bishop for Ukrainians in Poland. Rev. Dr PRYSHLAK Mykhailo of Rome was sent in 1967 to the Cardinal WYSZYNSKI with a message from the State Secretariat of Vatican on the matter. Cardinal Wyszynski was reported to have given in to the Pope's pressure and the nomination of Rev Hrynyk to a bishopship ~~had~~ should be soon announced.
