The Bethlehem Globe Times (sometime late 1967) carried following info: left for Soviet Union Aug 29, 1967. "While such a trip probably would be beyond even wildest dreams of most young men, it was for Petryk simply a most logical means of combining his adventuresome spirit and love of travel with his ambition to become a mechanical engineer. At his destination, he applied for, and was accepted into the University of Kiev.

What makes Petry's trip different from most others is fact it was not arranged through any formal government or private agency established for the purpose. Arranged and financed solely by himself. The idea was born only last spring when a Ukrainian playwright, making a lecture tour of the U. S., paid a brief visit to the Petryk family.
