CASS-2 telephoned this afternoon. Letter received from State Insurance people (signed by R. Eiros) informing Prolog that they would be at the Prolog offices on Friday, 2 May to survey books, tax reports, etc.

CASS-2 said "Mr. Tom" should be informed.*

CASS-2 will call tomorrow to advise of the definite date of his departure. He plans to go to Paris first for 2-3 days.
