2. The tape was returned to [C] [] by WEMCA section after being run once at PYREX. It was found that the audio level begins to fluctuate considerably after the first five or six minutes of play rendering the tape unuseable.

3. We suggest that a more careful check of tapes be made by producers prior to turning them over to KUBARK. We also suggest that the recording equipment used by AERODYNAMIC be thoroughly checked.
