We regret that Headquarters has no advance information to offer to the Field with regard to the trade fairs listed in Reference. **AMBASSADOR/2** likewise had no advance information on these events nor on Soviet personalities expected to attend. As such information is usually available first locally, it is suggested that you contact the stations and bases which are in or near the fair locations and levy your questions and requirements on them directly.

2. Whatever the lack of information available prior to these events, it seems safe to assume that in any all-Union group of Soviet representatives, at least 10 or 15 per cent will be Ukrainian. The extent to which you exploit such events will probably be governed by the degree to which **AMBASSADOR/29** is occupied with tasks of higher priority. It is our opinion that coverage of trade fairs is secondary in importance to **REBBIKIN**-in operations, although we do not suggest that they be neglected completely. A balanced operational program should explore all operational avenues simultaneously.

3. While Soviet delegations at international fairs are fair game for contact operations, we should like to encourage the Field to investigate with equal vigor the operational possibilities at scientific and professional conferences and conventions, generally attended by Soviet Ukrainians of higher calibre than the attendants whom we meet at trade fairs. It is recognized, of course, that the trick is to find **AMBASSADOR/1** collaborators who are qualified to attend such conferences as delegates, a status which puts them in an advantageous position for Soviet contacts.

4. You recently received a translation of **AMBASSADOR/29**'s report on contact operations at the Marseilles Fair last summer. We found it fairly representative of conditions at such events. We say fairly representative
