MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, TFW/CA

SUBJECT : Mail to Cuba

1. For your information, the following was reported to this office by AECASSOWARY/2.

2. Bohdan HALAJCZUK, Professor of International Law at the University of Buenos Aires, who is a collaborator and supporter of AECASSOWARY/1, a CIA financed and controlled group, recently met with Dr. Raul de Juan, head of the delegation of the Cuban Revolutionary Council in Argentina. In discussing means for sending to Cuba, Prologo, a semi-monthly journal of which Professor HALAJCZUK is editor, Dr. Raul de Juan told him that nothing is presently being mailed to Cuba because of strict censorship. Instead, he said, they distribute material via airplanes which depart from "a nearby airfield on the Caribbean Sea". He said leaflets are dropped wherever convenient and that packets of newspapers are dropped in designated areas where they are picked up by organized members of the underground who also obtain arms and medical supplies via this means. Dr. Juan recommended that Professor HALAJCZUK discuss his distribution problem with the Cuban Revolutionary Council in Miami and with the president of the commission on doctrines and propaganda, Dr. Jose I. Liasaga.
