MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, SR/RP

1. A letter dated 1 June 1962 from a Ukrainian in Wroclaw, Poland, states that a friend of his "recently" visited Lvov and Kiev. The friend reported that in Kiev, along the Dnieper, there was a cave in of over 30 hectares of land, along with buildings in the area, so that only the rooftops of 5-story homes could be seen. A large children's playground and a hospital for nervous disorders were lost, along with the occupants and others present in the area at the time. The large amount of water and silt made it impossible to save anything or anyone.

2. In Odessa (exact date not given but writer states "this year"), dock employees refused to load butter on ships destined for Cuba. They dumped all the butter into the sea. As a result all those involved were arrested.
