1. Agreement has been reached with the Sub-regional CIC, Munich whereby the liquidation of Bunker 1/B-P/5 can be postponed until further details on its members are learned.

2. CIC has agreed to "play along" with the plan of hiring the imprisoned Maria BYTSCH (cf MSC 274, §C-7) as their informant. Maria BYTSCH is a member of the Bunker, and she was in communication with her boss, Andrij PECZARA while in jail; she assured PECZARA that "the CIC still did not ask her any questions concerning 'our' matters". - From this fact it is obvious that Maria BYTSCH could not be asked questions on the Munich Bunker without thereby letting the rest of its members know that their activity is known to us. The simple fact is that IN MUNICH WE HAVE NO JAIL FROM WHICH THE PRISONER CANNOT COMMUNICATE OUTSIDE.

3. Because then we are not ready to "liquidate" the Bunker, and because we cannot ask Maria BYTSCH any questions on the Bunker without tipping our to her collaborators, AB-43 obtained concurrence of the local CIC holding her to take following steps:

- (a) Interrogate her on her knowledge of the Ukrainian organizations, stressing their illegal status and their distribution of illegal literature (like, for instance, the ABN booklet 'Pour la Liberte des Peuples')
- (b) Propose to her that she becomes CIC informant on the 'Ukrainian underground' in Munich; especially to inform on some UPA and ABN personalities. Here a list of known UPA members was compiled; in this list is included the name of PECZARA, chief of the Munich Bunker, and at the same time an UPA member, according to his ready admission (a fact which he never fails to advertise). The people on which she is to inform are as follows:
- ca JURKIEWICZ, (her boy friend), MSC 266 §1)
 - ca KALYNA, (known to her as alias of LOPATYNSKIJ,
 - ca KASCHUBA,
 - ca Dr. MITSCHUK (well known Ukr. leader), also spelled
 - ca MASNYYE, MIRTCHUK
 - ca MARTYNEC,
 - ca PECZARA, (chief of Bunker 1/B-P/5)
 - ca ~~ASTEC~~
- (c) Release her as a hired CIC informant.

4. Once released Miss BYTSCH is expected to relate the complete story on our interest in her to PECZARA. Whatever she will report to us on the Ukrainians will be on instruction from PECZARA. Points of interest in her future reports will be:

- (a) Will the Ukrainian groups be denounced by PECZARA as dangerous subversive elements?
- (b) Will "KALYNA" alone be denounced? What is known to PECZARA on "KALYNA's" activity?
- (c) Will PECZARA explain that he is only a nominal member of the UPA, or will he still emphasize his importance in the Ukrainian activity?

5. NOTE by AB-43: This operation will also be a test case of how CIC interprets our agreement with them at cooperation. It would be only fair to state at this point that no good will is lacking on either side to help each other. (All info of direct CIC interest locally will be given them informally as it is received in the process of this operation.).
