CONTACT REPORT

8 June 1954

SUBJECT: Meeting with AECASSOWARIES 4 and 15.

1. Cass 4 arrived from NY in order to arrange to take over as contact with me during the time Cass 15 goes on his vacation (9 June to 9 July). The arrangements are that I will call Cass 4 either once a week on a pre arranged date beginning with 11 June or at any other time if the need to do so exists. In the event Cass 4 is needed for consultations, etc. in Wash. he will arrive here within twentyfour hours after being notified. Cass 15 gave him the keys to his apt. to Cass 4 where any meetings are to be held.

2. Cass 4 brought with him a letter received in Canada and sent by CARTHAGE 12. (see under AECARTHAGE 12 S/W letters IN) After making a copy of the open text of the letter, it was given to me for developing. The s/w text was given to Cass 4. The envelope in which the letter was mailed was not brought down by Cass 4 who promised to bring it with him the next time he visits Wash.

3. Cass 4 mentioned that a friend of his received a letter from the Soviet Union which was censored in Czechoslovakia. Since this sounded unusual, I requested that he show me this letter at some future date. He said he would. He also mentioned that a friend received a letter from the SU in which the writer openly criticized the Communist regime, etc. The letter was evidently not censored. Cass 4 promised to show me this letter also.

4. Cass 4 also gave me a photo copy of the letter written by an Ukrainian in Denmark to the Suchasna Ukraina requesting printed material not to be given to Soviet seamen making a port of call in his city. (Cass 2 said he would furnish this man's name and address when he returns from Europe)

5. Cass 15 got a card from Cass 2 while I was visiting him in which Cass 2 states that he was on his way from Italy to Swiss to meet Korkiuk, Pidhainy, et.al., and that he was informed by someone from Munich that he was extended an invitation to visit the Island (England). He did not say whether he would make this visit or not. (Smyopia was informed that Cass 2 went to Europe and it was expected that they would request to see Cass 2 although they have not said anything to us about it as of 9 June).

6. I asked both Cass 4 and 15 whether they knew HOREAK or BENTSAL. They said yes, that HOREAK was a former PA and that BENTSAL Yaroslav was a Bandera follower. (some question came up from the CE (Kinnetham Knowles) re these people.

7. After leaving Cass 4 and 15 about 2 PM, I returned to Cass 15's horse about 7:30 PM to give them the s/w message in C-12's letter.

8. Cass 4 said he was to see the real estate agent on 9 June about the house for the Ranter Project. He said that if nothing was found in Astoria or Queens on this day that he would seek for a house in either Conkers or in NJ in the Hackensack area.

9. On 9 June about 1200 C 15 left for his trip and C4 returned to NY.
