Although [] had limited contact with AECASSOWARY-29 several years ago, there have been no further meetings with this asset since the attempt by [] in mid-1966 to place [] in touch with members of the Ukrainian Mission. This contact represented the sole extent of [] involvement with assets assigned to this project, which was then, and still is, directed by SB Division from Headquarters. [] agrees that Subject's statements during his previous sojourn in the United States and his GRU affiliation warrant every effort to re-establish contact between him and AECASSOWARY-33. Since [] has not had any contact with the latter, we would suggest that this matter be brought to the attention of the appropriate office in SB Division.

2. [] has in the past received samples of AECASSOWARY reporting on individual Soviets stationed in New York City such as SX-5857, which was forwarded as an attachment to Reference A. We wish to continue to receive similar reports for our files in the future, but request that such reports be forwarded under a covering dispatch explaining relevant operational detail, e.g., the cryptonym of the contacting agent. We would also appreciate Headquarters comments on the current status of LNERGO involvement in these contacts, which was implied in Reference B.
