Registration of AERODYNAMIC Newspaper with German Authorities

1. With the receipt of sovereignty by the Bonn Federal Government, emigre organizations who publish various periodicals have been faced with the need of registering their publications with the appropriate German authorities. This registration requirement necessitated that the publication sponsor, organization or individuals, be identified openly and that the publication make public its financial status including source of income and the expenditures incurred in the printing of the publication.

2. In line therewith, AECASSOWARY 1 representatives met on 29 December 1955 in order (a) to reorganize the editorial staff of the AECASSOWARY 1 newspaper and (b) to create a representative body, consisting of several individuals, who would be recognized as the ostensible sponsors of the publication. The untranslated AECASSOWARY 3 report, forwarded under separate cover, indicates the nature of the reorganization and the action taken to satisfy the requirements of the German authorities.
