<p>1. There appears to be some confusion as to the slugs and cryptonyms to be used in correspondence in connection with the AENOBLE project. It is requested that the following procedures <del>shall be</del> be followed to assure the proper Headquarters distribution and routing of correspondence traffic concerning internal agents now designated as AENOBLE 5, AENOBLE 6, and AEGIDEON 601.</p> <p>2. AENOBLE as presently written is an independently financed KUFIRE sub-project of the former Project cryptonym, and will continue as such under Project AEGIDEON. This independent financial status is necessary not so much for funding approval, since as you are aware the opportunities for spending funds on the old AENOBLE project have for the past few years been few and far between. It is, however, necessary for KUFIRE Staff review, in order to separate the formalized internal agent type of activity conducted in concert with AEGIDEON from the numerous other activities, all of which to date have been subject only to KULAGE Staff review. In addition, the SR Division internal routing requires a separation of this material from the over-all AEGIDEON activities.</p> <p>3. Although Project AENOBLE originally covered only the joint AEGIDEON 1-KUBARK REDSOX agents, as now written the Project covers all internal USSR agents recruited through AEGIDEON 1. Please see the AEGIDEON project outline, paragraph 4.A.(8). (Renewal of AENOBLE is now pending. We will send you a copy of the renewal as soon as it is approved.) Under present plans, any REDCAP recruit developed through AEGIDEON 12 will be transferred to AENOBLE when he returns to the USSR.</p> <p>4. The file number of this activity will continue to be 74-6-139. For the reasons noted above, however, it is necessary to keep the correspondence procedures separate.
