10. <u>Action Reported by the Field:</u>						
<p>1. AEVIRGIL-7 returned to Munich from the United States on 19 September. He reported that he was well satisfied with the results of his trip and with the formation of the new AEVIRGIL-1 chapter in the U.S. A permanent secretary for the chapter was found and clearance has been obtained for her use. During the first few months of its existence, the chapter has provided AEVIRGIL-1 with leaflet texts and articles for AEVIRGIL-70. Present plans call for an extension of its activities in the future.</p>						
<p>2. AEVIRGILS J and 106 reported to Radio Nacional in Madrid on 19 September. They were very warmly greeted by all of the emigre factions including the Falts. Indications are that 106 is doing a good job and [REDACTED] is most optimistic regarding the possibility of AEVIRGIL-1 predominance in the Spanish section.</p>						
<p>3. AEVIRGIL-71 still has not received governmental status but AEVIRGIL-1 has been told that the delay does not mean that any serious difficulties have developed.</p>						
<p>4. The field has proposed that all ^{AEvirgil-1} subsidy money with the exception of some quarters allowances should be funded through legal channels. They propose also that we can consider funding AEGACOTOL and AEGARHENA by means of the same mechanism, though there would be definite difficulties in implementing this suggestion. At any rate, the target for initiating AEVIRGIL-1 legal funding is now 1 November.</p>						
<p>5. The AEVIRGILITES are quite enthusiastic about the results of their EMERGENCY meeting. From the standpoint of the impression created in the minds of the predominantly German audience. After the meeting several people expressed their thanks and their interest in further cooperation in matters which are of mutual concern to AEVIRGIL-1 and the German population. The field is by no means as happy about the lack of publicity which the meeting received, although the election campaign was at its height at the time. A resolution expressing the feelings of the participants of the meeting and advocating just and stern action with regard to the UN Report will be translated into French and English and sent to each national delegation at the UN together with a letter from AEVIRGIL-1 on behalf of the meeting participants.</p>

6. AEWINGIL plans for the exploitation of the Fortieth Anniversary of the Bolshevik Revolution were outlined to Headquarters by the field. A series of two public meetings was planned for Berlin. One was to be organized for the general public and the second was to be of a scientific character with the limited participation of outstanding individuals in the Russian field from several European countries. AEWINGIL-1 received promises of support from prominent Germans in this endeavor. However, it was later decided that the so-called scientific meeting should be postponed in view of the fact that several of the big names which would have added prestige to the conference were unable to attend. Instead, it is the field's intention to stage a press conference on behalf of DS-776 provided Headquarters concurs.

7. DS-776 spent a period of time in Munich with the AEWINGILITES in the course of September. Everyone seemed impressed with his intelligence, general knowledge and realistic attitude. The general opinion was that he would be an extremely useful addition to the group. Indications are that he is developing an increasing interest in political work, although his primary interest is still eventual PEPRIME resettlement.

8. Issue No. 9-10 of AEWINGIL-70 was distributed late in the month. A 10th issue was necessary by virtue of the fact that AEWINGIL-7 returned later than expected from the United States and AEWINGIL-6 was on vacation.

9. Preparatory work for issue No. 13 of AEWINGIL-71 was carried on during the month. The general theme of the publication will be the Fortieth Anniversary of the Bolshevik Revolution. The AEWINGIL-1 print shop turned out 5,276,000 DIN-A-7 leaflet units during the month.

10. A total of 10,825,250 DIN-A-7 leaflet units were ballooned in twenty-three actions by the AEWINGIL balloon team during the month. An attempt was made to ~~set~~ ^{hit} the maneuver areas in the ITH. This output is twice the total for any previous month and the team is to be congratulated for its fine effort. Mention *Much* of the slack in AECACOTOL operations has thereby been taken up.

11. The latest report which we have on AECACOTOL balloon operations is for the period 1-20 August. The team, which now operates primarily in West Germany due to the hydrogen squeeze in Berlin, ballooned a total of 5,130,232 DIN-A-7 units in the reporting period. Our latest information is that the hydrogen generator which Headquarters proposes to send to Berlin is nearing the end of its tests and will be transported to Berlin shortly thereafter. It is interesting to note that in the two years during which it has been operating, the team has launched 17,597 balloons carrying 178,451,000 DIN-A-7 units with a total weight of about eighty tons.
