1. Major NADAS, former Hungarian colonel and now a staff member of MIHK, showed GVA's 17585 a letter sent by Legation AGH from the USA. AGH reported in his letter to NADAS that he had been in frequent negotiations with an officer of the 'central American intelligence service'. However, this American officer had finally stated that the American intelligence was completely satisfied with their three lines bringing out intelligence from Hungary, and that it was not planned to lay on additional chains.

2. The above information comes from GVA, and is dated 1 October. Source 17585 assumes that ZAKO had requested AGH to bring up directly in the USA ZAKO's offer of an intelligence network into Hungary.
