<p>Editor of the Voelkische Beobachter, Schwarze Korps and connected with the "Reich" is the son of a German businessman of Essen, despite his foreign sounding name. He is a young man (born in 1910) who joined the young Nazis in 1925. He is quite a clever and adroit propagandist. On the Reich, for which Paul Schaffer (New York) worked, his orders were to adopt a tone of reasonableness, which Goebbels held would be the best means of impressing the soldiers and officers who were to be provided with "material for thought" by the Reich. The Reich was beamed at those who could not be caught by vulgar sheets such as the Schwarze Korps.</p>
