MEMORANDUM FOR: CCP

SUBJECT: Utilization of the Services of GUNTER d'ALQUEM,
a Former High Placed Nazi Psychological Warfare
Expert

1. Since GUNTER d'ALQUEM appears to be an exceptionally able propaganda expert, and to be eager to work for U.S. interests, it seems to me that it could be advantageous to ask the chief of the German Mission to review the correspondence on file at the Headquarters of our German Mission in this case, and to examine into the situation in which d'ALQUEM now finds himself. With these data on hand a decision can then be reached as to whether CCP can utilize his services.

2. I believe that the latest dispatch from the field in the matter is dated 22 June 1949 and indicates that the investigation of d'ALQUEM then made was left in an early exploratory stage.

3. It may be that no immediate utilization of the services of this individual is feasible, but he seems to be potentially so valuable that we should not lose track of him and that, as above suggested, it would be desirable to ascertain his present whereabouts and obtain an up-to-date appraisal of his possible use to us.
