APYRUBIS, Ignas, born 4 September 1899 at Mitau, Latvia

Information at this headquarters indicates that subject applied for a United States visa in May 1956. (B-2) In an interview, subject stated that he had made application for a U.S. visa in 1951 but that he had withdrawn it because of his mother-in-law's sickness. When he later applied to have his application reinstated, the quota had been filled. Subject was a member of the association of Lithuanians in Germany since 1949. Since 1953, subject had been a member of the Central Welfare Association. (F-6) Information dated March 1950 reveals that one Ignas APYRUBIS, was sentenced for four (4) years imprisonment while serving in the Lithuanian Army for forgery in 1933. APYRUBIS was later released after serving one year of the sentence and was reinstated to full rank. (Unevaluated) The results of subject's application for a visa are unknown.
