

APYRUBIS, Ignas

Subject's file, [redacted] reflects an Inter-Office Memorandum dated 29 March 1950, which contained the following information re one IGNA APYRUBIS.

An unevaluated source indicated that one IGNAS APYRUBIS, a naturalized German Citizen, has been sentenced by court martial to four years imprisonment for forgery while he was a captain in the Lithuanian Army in 1933. APYRUBIS claimed that after serving one year (1936-37) his case was reviewed and he was reinstated into the Lithuanian Army with his former rank and his rights and privileges restored. According to APYRUBIS story, his forgery merely consisted in signing a supplies name to a requisition form to facilitate action.
