We are particularly concerned about the chance meeting between ANCOBSAIR/3 and Subject of reference A, from the point of view of possible security dangers to ANCOBSAIR/3's regular operational activity. In addition to the contact report on Subject meeting, please give us your opinion of the security risks involved as well as your present thinking on any possible exploitation of this incident.</p> <p>2. From paragraph 5 of reference A one can conclude that the Soviets are interested in ANCOBSAIR/3. Therefore, we suggest that ANCOBSAIR/3 be put on ice operationally and that his sensitive contacts be limited for a period of several months.
