1. <sup>X</sup> Former Colonel KAGAWA Yasuo (香川 義雄), formerly attached to the Second Section of the Army General Staff, is now engaged exclusively in organizing an espionage KIKAN to work against foreign powers. Direction and funds for this KIKAN come from NAKANO Tetsu.

2. AKISUE Seigo is being condemned as a "conspirator strategist" (RAIHOEN-KAI SHIKUIN-KAI) and has been ostracized by members of the former SAKURA KAI group.

1. <sup>X</sup> NAKANO Tetsu Shimbun, former president of ROKKEI News Agency, has split with the KIKU KIKAN, and is planning to establish a SHIMAN KIKAN which will form the basis for an independent movement for the reconstruction of Japan. (Date of Info: 2 June 1951; date acquired: 3 June 1951)
