SYNOPSIS OF FACTS:

Subject organization changed its name from Friends of New Yugoslavia at the suggestion of Yugoslav Government officials in order to increase its effectiveness as a propaganda medium. Yugoslav diplomatic and Consular officials reported in attendance at the meeting of subject organization on 4/8/51 in New York City; speeches given at this and other meetings reflect full support of Marshal TITO'S domestic and foreign policies and informants report closest cooperation between subject organization and Yugoslav Government officials in this country.
