1. The cause of death of subject, as requested in reference, was Delerium Tremens. A copy of a medical statement to that effect is forwarded under separate cover.
2. [] and I saw [] on 3 October 1958. The Jugendamt authorities have advised him that they are willing that the boy go to the United States for the purpose of adoption by Mr. and Mrs. Lidacis. They will not insist that the adoption actually take place in Germany. As you know, [] is now in touch with [] and it appears that the case is in good hands on both ends. [] was planning to talk to the Consulate within the next few days about the boy's immigration. He seems confident now that the case will go smoothly and is of the opinion that if the Social Service investigation in the United States does not take too long, the boy will be ready to sail in time to be escorted by Mrs. Werner even if she should receive her visa immediately and therefore have to leave within the next four months.
3. For your information, it seems that Mrs. Werner is expressing an unusual amount of anxiety over the boy's welfare and may possibly be becoming a little too possessive for our peace of mind. However, it seems the only answer to this is expeditious action, which is now being taken. Mrs. Werner is also attempting to get relatively small amounts of money for the same expenditures from several different sources. For example, she was paid the cost of the boy's recent hospital expenses by us although we are reasonably sure that she will eventually be paid by the Jugendamt. In spite of this, she complained to [] when he saw her recently that she has not been reimbursed for those same hospital expenses, and he took the initiative, reasonably enough, of suggesting to [] that Mr. and Mrs. Lidacis might be asked to pay Mrs. Werner for these expenses. He has since been told the facts and will advise []
4. All of the above is simply for your information for whatever it may be worth, and to let you know that although the case seems to be running smoothly, Mrs. Werner may yet prove to be troublesome. We shall keep our fingers crossed on this end and hope that you will join us in our supplication.
