1. LERHAD's interest in subject has been rekindled because of his alleged activities in Bolivia, and thus LERHAD retains an interest in reestablishing contact with him for purposes of assessing his present capabilities. At this point in time LERHAD is still not contemplating a formal request for coordination of clandestine use of subject.

2. In April 1967 LERHAD representatives met with WOFIRM representative to obtain additional information. It is therefore requested that [] once again review its files to determine the accuracy of information in the following additional data not previously passed to [] in Reference A. Please note that neither liaison nor unilate. assets are to be used.

- a. Subject became a naturalized Bolivian citizen in 1957.
- b. At one time he worked as a mechanic in La Paz on Calle Montevideo 126.
- c. In March 1965 a firm ALTMANN allegedly operated a carpenter shop in the upper Sopicachi area, La Paz, on Calle Pedro de la Gasca, across from #671. Firm ALTMANN reportedly often travelled to Santa Cruz and Caranavi to buy lumber.
- d. Also in the Spring of 1965, a firm ALTMANN, an individual of German origin, and resembling photographs of subject, was allegedly operating a lumber yard in Santa Rosa.
- e. In addition to subject's friendship with Hans RUDDEL, previously reported in Reference A, subject is alleged to maintain some kind of a business connection with Otto SKORZENY, noted for his aerial exfiltration of B. MUSSOLINI from Italy.
