The Count is very calm and resigned. After having received a telegram from the Countess he is awaiting her back though he had never thought of this possibility before. He is never talking about Spain or about a flight, but he wants to go to Italy and do something against Badoglio and the king whom he hates. He would also like to go back to the Air Forces. He is wondering why there is no more violent propaganda against the Savoya, for instance the Italians would be very impressed by hearing about the pedherasty of the crown prince, some episods are known by acts in Rome. The crown princess herself told Ciano about it, she is hating her husband. The first two children were spun babies. The father of the third child was(unreadable) and of the fourth a praetore from Cortina d'Ampezzo. Speaking of the members of the new Government the Couhnt said Graziani and Pavolini were the best of them.

Speaking of his things left in Rome he told me by the way that ~~xxx~~ that for three hours he had been burning personal papers because the house was watched.
