CAMISE

Subject was sent to Italy by the RSdA, Amt VI on a special mission in 1941, where she was the secretary to Dr. HOETTL. To obtain certain information from Count CIANO, she was placed as his secretary. She was responsible for getting Edda CIANO into Switzerland and after subject's arrest in June 1945, she gave much information re the recovery of the famed CIANO diaries.

Since her employment by us she has held several positions -- secretary with the Bavarian Red Cross; with a translating establishment in Munich (she is very fluent in languages). Her most recent position has been at OMGUS, where she was placed by us in the hope that she would attract the Russians to her, would be approached by them and possibly recruited in order that we could then play her back as a double. This plan, however, failed because the Russians did not seem to be interested.

Finally through CAMISADE, we were able to make SKURIN aware of subject. We arranged to have subject present in the French Zone with the information of this trip made known to SKURIN through CAMISADE, in the hope that SKURIN would arrest her, but he refused to bite at the bait we had extended. It is to be assumed that SKURIN will handle subject's case in a different manner -- he instructed CAMISADE not to contact subject again.
