Gamise's Ex-husband

1. I discussed Gamise's ex-husband with Gamise and have come to the decision that he is not a very worthy subject for any recruiting attempts. Gamise told me that her husband was shocked by her willingness to cooperate with the Americans - that he belongs to the type of Germans that believe in the motto of non-fraternization with the Americans and that he would never be willing to undertake to work for any of the occupying powers. This sentiment, according to Gamise, does not stand for militarism or for nationalism, but is a manifestation of national pride.

2. An interesting development in Mr. Gamise's life is his recent turn to religion. He is still studying philosophy and I have asked Gamise to keep me advised on his mental and political development.
