| <p>1. Subject is CAMISE [redacted] (Identity).</p> <p>2. In a review of potential operational leads to OKELUSION, based on a listing of former contacts of [redacted], we have identified Subject not only as a contact of [redacted]; but also as a former encrypted agent targetted during World War II against the Nazis and in the post-war period against the East German regime, and possibly the Soviets. We would appreciate an operational summary of what we imagine may be fairly voluminous file holdings in Headquarters. To simplify the task, we are essentially interested in the following:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">a. Nature and duration of operational relationship.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">b. Extent of control, payment, ideological commitments, etc., during the period of operational exploitation.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">c. Tasking for operational or reporting purposes.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Reason for termination of operational relationship(s). It would appear that there was an intensive operational relationship up to approximately 1960 and a looser "contact"-type relationship with [redacted] possibly without reference to the earlier association.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">d. Any "handles" for facilitating an introduction to Subject with throw-back to the period of most effective operational exploitation.</p> | | |
