COB traces on former Colonel Hans MARTIN:

1. Attached hereto is a photocopy of MSC/OPR/043, 25 April 1947. Although this contains very little information on Subject, we forward the entire document as the appearance of MARTIN's name in conjunction with others listed may be of interest.

2. Oberst a.D. Hans MARTIN, Hurlingen/Wtbg, Kirchstrasse, is listed as one of the people with whom Wilhelm KIEFER discussed his plans for the formation of a new rightist party in Germany. KIEFER was an active promoter of Die Bruderschaft, overtly supported the neutralist OVP, and was suspected of working for the French IS and of possibly being in contact with the Russians.
