1. Since reference, additional correspondence addressed to Subject or his wife has been forwarded to MLB for analysis in keeping with the procedure originally instituted. On 31 March 1961 CALLIKAK provided us with a letter addressed to Dr. Beisner which, because of its content, merits complete translation and speedy dissemination to addressees.

2. For the benefit of addressees, except MLB and EE who are aware of this, we must state that the CALLIKAK coverage on Beisner was originated by UNION right after Beisner had been involved in the bombing accident. We are getting an extra copy of this coverage unbeknownst to [] since CALLIKAK is an ODLBEX installation and, through our liaison, generally aware of matters of interest to us. The fact that we have access to Beisner's incoming mail must therefore remain restricted to KURARK personnel.

3. As a result of the letter translated below and the suspicion that UPHILL has had or may still have some type of connection to Beisner, it has occurred to us that the real initiator of the Beisner coverage was UPHILL and that [] is acting as a cutout for UPHILL in order not to record UPHILL's interest in Beisner with us. Since the coverage was initiated at a time when Identity-1 was the liaison officer to UPHILL, this could have been done quite easily. *Cal. MERCER ([])*

4. The envelope of the letter quoted below is postmarked 25.3.61-15h DAMAS and carries the following typewritten return address at the top of the back flap: G. Rischer, P.O. Box 635, Damascus/Syria, JAR.

5. The letter reads as follows: (Formal "you" is used throughout.)

"Dear Comrade Beisner: Heartfelt thanks for your letter of 15 February 1961. In reply I can state that I have been assured that nothing is known here why you would not be allowed to come here. On the contrary, my friends would be delighted to talk with you face to face. And I would be particularly delighted if we could see each other. For various reasons, however, this creature (diese Kreatur) is still in my apartment. If this would not be the case, you would have to stay with me.

"Above all I am delighted that you have been discharged from the hospital. Please be patient with your first walking attempts.

"In regard to the other (person) in Beirut, Mr. Spaeth has been constantly on the road. He (Spaeth) wrote me unbelievable things on this. I assume that he will surely visit you now since this matter has been concluded. When he visits you he should phrase the article in such a manner that it will not be misinterpreted here. He (Spaeth) is certain that Sch. will then be jailed. A few days ago I read his January 1961 issue of afro-asia. This contained such attacks and lies against the UAR or Egypt and Syria and our leading personalities that they can be exactly equated with the Zionist propaganda against Germany since 1936.

"In regard to the cement factory project, I must wait until my acquaintance von Doha returns. If it should be of actual interest and Kirchofeld should drop it or absolutely need competition, I shall write you all details.
