1. *AMIR *REMAFFANI, diplomat, passport No. 675, issued on 9 January 1951, at Hakiryra, departed from the Ciampino airport for Tel Aviv on 6 February 1951.
2. *BEN *NATHAN Asher, born at Vienna on 15 February 1918, head of the Israel Intelligence Service, coming allegedly from Hakiryra, arrived in Rome on 31 December and on 1 January 1951 departed for London. In Rome he stayed at the Hotel Bernini Bristol where he exhibited ordinary passport No. 519 issued on 19 July 1950 at Hakiryra, in which he is qualified as an inspector. (Hand slip attached)
3. *BAHAL David, service passport No. 299, issued on 13 January 1949, at Hakiryra, coming from Jerusalem, arrived at the Ciampino Airport on 3 October 1950. On 7 October 1950 he again came to Rome and took lodgings at the Hotel Bernini Bristol.
4. *BERE MAN *YEOVDITH, diplomatic passport No. 015, issued at Hakiryra on 10 October 1948, arrived in Rome on 19 January 1951 and took lodgings at the Hotel Flora.
5. *BURG Josef, Israel Vice President, Diplomatic passport No. 500 issued on 2 July 1950 at Hakiryra, arrived in Rome on 18 October and on 19 October departed for Hakiryra. He stayed at the Hotel Quirinale.
6. *BEZNER Itzhak, head of the Israel Mission in New York, special passport No. 488, issued on 5 December 1949, at Hakiryra, arrived in Rome on 19 February and on 21 February departed from the Ciampino airport for Lydda, accompanied by his wife and two children.
7. *BRISSTADT Samule, passport No. C2852, issued on 21 March 1949, at Tel Aviv, coming from Prague, arrived at the Urbe Airport on 28 November 1949, and on 29 November departed from the airport for Lydda.
8. *BRUAT *WITZMAN, Director of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, diplomatic passport No. 674, issued on 9 January 1951 at Hakiryra, entered Italy at Chiasso on 13 February and on 2 March 1951 departed from the Ciampino Airport for Tel Aviv.
9. *BYLON Abraham, service passport No. 374, issued at Hakiryra on 28 January 1951, arrived in Rome on 4 March 1951, and took lodgings at the Hotel Bernini Bristol.
