DESCRIPTION	Brisk manner; great intriguer.	
CAREER	Former Latvian Minister of the Interior and right-hand man of President ULMANIS; escaped from Latvia with a passport in the name of KOKS and arrived in Sweden in August 1940; obtained a Manchurian passport, probably in Helsinki, in 1940; Axis agent; in touch with the Japanese Legation, Stockholm; when in Riga considered to be pro-German and thoroughly untrustworthy; wife and family still in Latvia in 1941.
